Devices for Accessing Google Classroom

In addition to laptops, chrome books, iPads and tablets the children can also access the learning through other devices. These are listed below with instructions on how to access learning through them.

Currently the only difference is that whereas you can actually work on the activities on laptops, chrome books, iPads and tablets, the children will have to complete the tasks on paper when accessing the work via these other devices.

GOOGLE CLASSROOM ON DIFFERENT DEVICES!

PLAYSTATION

To access Google Classroom on a PlayStation console, navigate to the browser. On the PS4, this is done by accessing the www icon, or failing that, in your Library, under Apps.

Type Google Classroom into the browser and follow the log in as usual.



XBOX

The Xbox's web browser can be found by navigating to the Microsoft Edge App. Open up the app and type Google Classroom into the browser to be directed to the log in page. Sign in as you would on a PC to access the programs listed above, as well as email.



NINTENDO WII

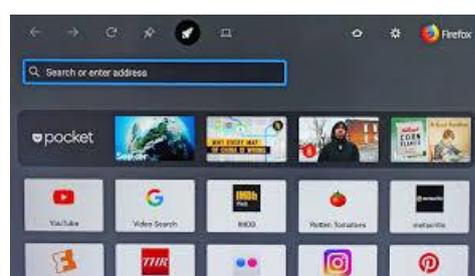
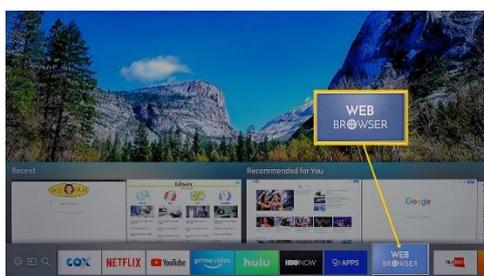
Select the **Internet** Channel, and then select Start to begin **browsing** the Web on your **Wii** console and search Google classroom.



SMART TV

Run the Internet Browser App

1. On your remote control, press the HOME or MENU button.
2. Select Apps or Applications. If the **Internet Browser** icon isn't displayed, go to All Apps or All Applications. ...
3. Select **Internet Browser**.
4. Type Google Classroom into the browser and follow the log in as usual.
